

## **ACCOMMODATIONS**

You'll have two options for accommodations: OSSO's house or a four- to five-star hotel upgrade.

OSSO's house: OSSO's houses in each city are like modern mini-apartment buildings, not the extravagance of a five-star hotel, nor the likes of a grass hut, but more like the houses many of our volunteers have grown up in. We have modern bathroom and kitchen facilities, complete with hot water. Our full-time Project Directors and our long-term volunteers (13-15 volunteers) live in the long-term housing portions of our houses, so while staying in the short-term housing portion you'll have the opportunity to interact with everyone in the common areas. You'll have a small, simple private room but may need to share a bathroom with a few other volunteers. You'll have access to a common stocked kitchen, a washer and dryer, wireless internet or desktop computer access, and a free internet phone to call home (to the U.S. and Canada only).

Hotel upgrade: if you prefer, you may upgrade and stay in a four- to five-star hotel. If you choose this option we'll help you make your reservation at the hotel of your choice, and then you'll pay the hotel directly. If you choose this option, we'll coordinate getting you to and from our house in order to get to the orphanages for shifts. You can also come to OSSO's house if you want to do laundry, internet, phone home, or just hang out with the other volunteers. However, just so you're aware, you may feel a little apart from everything and everyone else if you choose to do this. We don't discount the program fee for you to stay in a hotel, as it will require more transportation back and forth from the hotel for you or for our Visitor Coordinator.
