

INTERNET/PHONE ACCESS

Volunteers have free in-house access to two computers with high-speed internet (a wireless connection is also available in some parts of the houses for those who choose to bring their laptop). We also have an internet phone from which you can make calls to the U.S. and Canada for free, and you can also receive calls on this phone for free. The only cost is to those who are making the calls from the U.S. or Canada, because they'll be charged on their phone account as if they were calling an 801-area code Utah phone number. Rules for computer and internet phone usage will be made known to you after your arrival.

The internet connection is not always that great or reliable and sometimes doesn't work for periods of time...remember that you're in a third-world country...but in general it's pretty good.
