

## **NEW VOLUNTEER FAQ QUIZ**

After acceptance, there are certain things that we want to make sure you're aware of so that you can be fully prepared for this experience (and also to answer questions that we get asked all the time but that are addressed on our website).

Shortly after your acceptance you'll be sent an e-mail letting you know we signed you up to take the FAQ Quiz. This same e-mail will include your Username and Password to access [www.exambuilder.com](http://www.exambuilder.com) where you take all of the quizzes.

We estimate that reading the information will take approximately 30 minutes to an hour (for an average reader) without interruptions if you do it all in one sitting—and hopefully it will take you less time!

To take the quiz, we're estimating about 20-30 minutes, depending on your preparation—the more you prepare, and the better knowledge you have of the information, the easier and faster the quiz will be for you!

For this mandatory online quiz (open book), *you'll need to pass it within two weeks after your acceptance.* **You must get 100% in order to pass this quiz.** If you don't get 100% on your first attempt you will automatically be rescheduled to take it again until you pass it. If you read the sections below before attempting the quiz you should be able to pass it on your first attempt (especially since it's an "open-book quiz").

While you're not required to read all of the files on [www.orphanagesupport.org/volprogram.html](http://www.orphanagesupport.org/volprogram.html) until three weeks before your departure, we strongly encourage you to read through all of it **now**, to give you a better feel for what you'll be doing, and what'll be expected of you while in Ecuador. There's a lot of information there and there's some information that's more important than other info, but all of it is information that you need to know and will be helpful for you to know as you're preparing to go. For the files that have Cuenca/Quito in the name, you only need to read the ones that are for the city you're accepted to, either Cuenca or Quito.
