

STORING YOUR PICTURES

If you're bringing a digital camera you also need to make sure you bring your applicable accessories (cables, high capacity memory cards/USB drives, blank CDs to burn pictures to for storing—volunteers take TONS of pictures, so plan sufficiently for ways of storing your pictures).

You can temporarily download your pictures to the volunteer computers but will then need to have a memory card/USB memory device/blank CDs to transfer them to. The computers have crashed in the past and volunteers' pictures have been lost because they didn't follow our advice; pictures have also been accidentally or mistakenly deleted. So, you need to be responsible for making sure you save your pictures. If you leave them on the computer there's no guarantee that they'll be safe there; also all pictures are deleted when there's a group change. Large capacity USB memory devices are highly recommended because they can hold a ton of pictures. Also, if you want other volunteers' pictures, you'll need to plan for this before they leave and before you leave due to the computers being cleaned out with each group change.
